*20 That, however, is not the way of life you learned  
21 when you heard about Christ and were taught in  
him in accordance with the truth that is in Jesus.*

*22 You were taught, with regard to your former way

corrupted by its deceitful desires; 23 to be made  
new in the attitude of your minds; 24 and to put on  
the new self, created to be like God in true  
righteousness and holiness.*
